- · Quick start guide


If you have purchased a multi-handset pack there will be an extra handset, charger, power adaptor, and three AAA rechargeable batteries for each additional handset.

## CONNECT


## **Ø**NOTES

- · Use only the adaptors provided.
- Make sure the electrical outlets are not controlled by wall switches.
- The adaptors are intended to be correctly oriented in a vertical or floor mount position. The prongs are not designed to hold the plug in place if it is plugged into a ceiling, under-the-table or cabinet outlet.


## CONNECT THE TELEPHONE BASE



## CONNECT THE HANDSET CHARGER (FOR 17450 MULTI-HANDSET PACKS ONLY)



## INSTALL THE HANDSET BATTERY



- 1. Slide open the battery compartment cover.
- 2. One by one, insert 3 AAA batteries into the battery compartment, according to the polarity.
- 3. Slide the battery compartment cover back into place, until you hear a click sound.

### **Ø**NOTES

- · Use only the batteries provided.
- If the handset will not be used for a long time, disconnect and remove the batteries to prevent possible leakage.

## CHARGE THE BATTERIES

Place the handset in the telephone base to charge.

## DATE AND TIME SETTINGS

You will need to set the correct time and date so that you know when you received answering machine (applicable to model with answering machine) or call log entries.

## SET THE DATE FORMAT

- 1. Press MENU/OK and △/▼ to select HS SETTINGS.
- 2. Press MENU/OK and  $\triangle / \nabla$  to select CLOCK.
- 3. Press **MENU/OK** and  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  to select **DATE FORM**.
- Press MENU/OK and ▲ / ▼ to select your desired date format (DD-MM-YY or MM-DD-YY).
- 5. Press MENU/OK to confirm.

### SFT THE TIME FORMAT

- 1. Press MENU/OK and △/▼ to select HS SETTINGS.
- Press MENU/OK and ▲ / ▼ to select CLOCK.
- Press MENU/OK and ▲ / ▼ to select TIME FORM.
- Press MENU/OK and ▲ / ▼ to select your desired time format (12 HR or 24 HR).
- 5. Press **MENU/OK** to confirm.

## SET THE DATE AND TIME

- 1. Press MENU/OK and △/▼ to select HS SETTINGS.
- 2. Press MENU/OK and △ / ▼ to select CLOCK.
- 3. Press MENU/OK and ▲/▼ to select SET DATE.
- Press MENU/OK then enter the date according to DD-MM-YY or MM-DD-YY format. The date will be in the format you set.
- Press MENU/OK then enter the time information according to 12 HR or 24 HR format. The time will be in the format you set.
- 6. Press MENU/OK to confirm.

# ANSWERING MACHINE ANNOUNCEMENT

The announcement is the message a caller first hear when the answering machine answers their call. There is a pre-recorded announcement message or you can record your own.

### RECORD YOUR OWN ANNOUNCEMENT

- Press MENU/OK when the phone is not in use. Then, press ▲ / ▼ to scroll to ANS. SYS.
- 2. Press **MENU/OK** and  $\triangle / \nabla$  to scroll to **SET TAM**.
- 3. Press MENU/OK and ▲ / ▼ to scroll to TAM MSG.
- 4. Press **MENU/OK** and  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  to scroll to **RECORD**.
- 5. Press **MENU/OK**. The handset displays **RECORDING...**. Now speak into handset to record your message.
- 6. Press MENU/OK to confirm your selection.

## SOS EMERGENCY CALLS

You need to set the SOS numbers before you can make SOS Emergency Calls.

## PROGRAM THE SOS NUMBER

- Press MENU/OK when the phone is not in use, and then press ▲ / ▼ to scroll to SET SOS.
- 2. Press **MENU/OK** and  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  to scroll to **SOS NUMBER**.
- Press MENU/OK and ▲ / ▼ to scroll to SOS 1, SOS 2, SOS 3, SOS 4, or SOS 5.
- 4. Press MENU/OK twice to select ADD.
- 5. Enter the SOS emergency number, and then press **MENU/OK**.
- 6. Enter the name for the SOS emergency number, and then press **MENU/OK**.

### RECORD YOUR SOS MESSAGE

The SOS message is your own recorded message to be played directly when you make an emergency call. The default SOS message is "This is an emergency call. Please press any number key to start the conversation." You can record your own message using the handset. Make sure your SOS message recorded includes your name, the SOS message, and a request to far end on pressing any number key to start the conversation. You can also playback and listen to your SOS message or delete it.

- Press MENU/OK when the phone is not in use, and then press ▲ / ▼ to scroll to SET SOS.
- 2. Press MENU/OK and ▲ / ▼ to scroll to SOS MSG.
- 3. Press **MENU/OK** and  $\triangle / \nabla$  to scroll to **RECORD**.
- Press MENU/OK and the handset displays RECORDING. Now speak into handset to record your message.
- 5. Press MENU/OK to confirm.
